Viña Decana Tempranillo (Spain) – Delicious flavors of red cherries and vanilla layered with notes of toasted oak. Landshut Riesling (Germany) – This exquisite, well-balanced Riesling has a fruity bouquet with flavors of apricot and peach. Sunshine Bay Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) – Dry and light white wine. 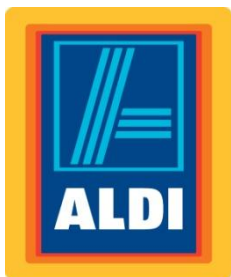
Burlwood Chardonnay (California) – Medium-bodied with delightful flavors of ripe peach and pineapple. Hints of toasted oak highlight a silky lingering finish. Burlwood Merlot (California) - Medium-bodied with luscious flavors of blueberry and black cherry combined with subtle notes of vanilla and toasty oak. Pairs with any meat or pasta. 2012 Beverage Testing Institute World Wine Championships Award – 85 points, Silver Medal & Best Buy (2009 vintage).

Burlwood Cabernet Sauvignon (California) - Medium to full-bodied red wine with robust flavors of black cherry and blackberry touched with aromas of toasted oak and spice.
