Easy DIY Office Mat Decor Materials:

- [Office Mat](#) – note: there are spikes on the bottom of office mats for rugs, and no spikes on office mats for hardwood floors.
- [Coral Blush DecoArt Americana Acrylic Paint](#)
- These [Apple Barrel Brand Acrylic Paints](#) were used on this project:
 - 21379 Pink Blush
 - [21481 Key West](#)
 - [21473 Pale Daffodil](#)
 - 21480 Lime Street
 - 20520 Lavender
- Paper Plates
- Disposable jar lids, buckets, bowls in various sizes
- [Rust-Oleum 2xUltra Cover Paint + Primer in Aqua Satin](#)
- Large Cardboard or Tarp

Optional:

- Straight Edge
- Sharpie
- Sharp Utility Knife

Easy DIY Office Mat Decor Directions:

- Optional:
 - Use a straight edge and make a line to cut off the lip of the chair mat.
 - Use a utility knife to cut the mat.
- On a protected (use cardboard or a tarp) and flat surface, begin to make your circles.
- Pour various colors of paint onto paper plates and stamp them into the paint and onto the mat. Take the circular disposable container (jar, paint can, etc), dip the rim into your paint, and then press onto your mat.

- Make the layout random and fun. Overlapping and even irregularly outlined circles are best.
- Allow to dry completely.
- Take your [Rust-Oleum 2xUltra Cover Paint + Primer in Aqua Satin](#) and paint the mat using long even strokes. Cover the dry paint circles.
- Allow to dry completely.
- Apply a second coat of the [Rust-Oleum 2xUltra Cover Paint + Primer in Aqua Satin](#) (or whatever color you have chosen for this project).
- Depending on the size of your mat, you will use the entire can.
- Let your Easy DIY Office Mat Décor dry for a minimum of 24 hours (until completely set) before putting onto the floor.
