DIY Graduation Bookmark Memento Materials:

- [Bookmark Cabochon Set](#)
- [Cutting Mat](#)
- Map
- [X-Acto Knife](#)
- [Mod Podge](#)
- [Foam Paint Brush](#)
- 4" x 6" [Card Stock](#)
- Printer
- [Hole Punch](#)
- String

DIY Graduation Bookmark Memento Directions:

- Place a [cutting mat](#) on a flat table surface.
- Spread out your map on top of the [cutting mat](#).
- Place a cabochon over the location you would like to cut out.
- Use an [X-Acto Knife](#) to cut around cabochon.
- **NOTE:** make certain to put a [cutting mat](#) or at the very least – a piece of cardboard – under your map so as not to ruin your surface underneath when you cut!
- Place a bit of [Mod Podge](#) on the bottom of the cabochon and place over your newly cut circle piece of the map.
- Allow to dry.
- Place a bit of [Mod Podge](#) where the cabochon will be placed in the bookmark.
- Place cabochon over the [Mod Podge](#) and press.
- Allow to dry.
- Line up where you expect to place the bookmark for a gift.

- Write up your sentiment based on a 4"x6" piece of [card stock](#) using word (or other document

software).

- Place 4"x6" [card stock](#) in printer and print an appropriate message for the person you are giving the gift to.
- This craft as made up is for a graduation gift. It says: **You're going places Never forget where you are from! Congratulations**
- The sentiment you choose to use may change based on whether or not it is a trip, a new job, a new home, etc.
- Using a [hole punch](#), make two holes the width of base of bookmark.
- Using a piece of string, loop it through the hole in the [card stock](#).
- Place the finished bookmark in the center of the holes.
- Tie the bookmark to the [card stock](#) using the threaded string.
- **Note:** use a [corner round punch](#) if so desired.
