Mica Bunny Soap Ingredients:

- 2/3 cup Shea Butter Glycerin Soap Base
- (2) .15cc scoops Cosmetic Grade Mica Powder (Hollywood Pink was used in this tutorial)
- ½ tsp Sweet Almond Oil
- 3 drops Lavender Essential Oil

Mica Bunny Soap Mise en Place:

- Large Glass Measuring Cup
- Silicone or Wooden Spoon or Stir Stick
- Silicone Bunny Mold
- Rubbing Alcohol (and spray bottle if needed)

Mica Bunny Soap Directions:

Mica Powders will stain so make sure you lay newspaper down before using.

- Lay down a covering to protect your work surface.
- Melt approximately 6-8 ice cube sized blocks of soaps in the microwave in a glass measuring cup (more or less until you have 2/3 cup of melted soap).
- Once completely melted, mix in your sweet almond oil and essential oil until combined.
- Now add in your mica powder and mix with a craft stick until the mica powder is completely dissolved.
- Carefully pour the melted soap into your bunny molds and lightly mist with rubbing alcohol to

prevent air bubbles from forming on the surface (optional).

- Freeze for 15-20 minutes and carefully remove each bunny from the molds (they should pop right out if you press up on the bottom).
