

Easy Unicorn Wreath DIY Instructions found on <u>AnnsEntitledLife.com</u>

Easy Unicorn Wreath DIY Materials:

- Scissors
- Ruler or Cutting Mat
- 12" Wreath Frame
- 1 yard Standard 42" Cotton Broadcloth with Sparkles
- 4 colors of tulle 3 3", 1 6" (the outer most layer is a little longer, hence the 6")
- 2 piece of Felt (for ears, pink and white were used)
- 1 sheet Glitter Scrapbook Paper (gold was used)
- Hot Glue
- Glue Gun
- <u>Printable Unicorn Ears</u>

Easy Unicorn Wreath DIY Directions:

• The 6" tulle used on the outer rim for a more "flow-y" look otherwise it will stick up like a Mohawk.

- Two sections are the mane (colored tulle), the rest is white.
- Fold the white broadcloth in half lengthwise.
- Fold the white broadcloth in half widthwise.

• Fold it again lengthwise (6" in length, but if not perfectly even it does not matter as this is a rag wreath projecting a unicorn coat)

- Cut into 1" strips.
- Tie into a knot around one section of the frame.

The colored tulle is as follows:

• Cut tulle into 6" lengths.

• 1/3 of the wreath is sparkly tulle. Do not do more than that as it will not give the illusion of a unicorn mane (if you do much more).

- Knot the tulle starting from the outermost frame bar and work in.
- The wreath has this inner knot order:

17 knots green (outermost, this is the 6" length and width tulle)

11 knots pink (3" width, 6" length)

8 knots blue (3" width, 6" length)

3 knots purple (innermost, (3" width, 6" length)

• Turn the knot over and pull the colors into each other.

• Once you have finished the colors, you can knot the white around the wreath.

• Cut out an outer ear and inner ear. You can use <u>this printable Unicorn ears template</u> if you do not want to freehand it!

- Lay the larger white ear down flat.
- Hot glue the smaller, pink inner ear to the center of the larger white ear.
- Cut a 4" x 8¹/₂" piece of gold scrapbook paper.
- Form a cone.

• Hot glue the cone together (a low heat glue gun may be useful if you have one).

• Cut the edge of the paper to form a point (you are clipping off a triangle of that gold paper to form a point).

• On the last full row of the white next to the colored tulle far vertical divider in back, this is where you will be inserting the horn, Two rows down, insert that pointy end of the gold paper you formed, push the white rag ties out of the way, pull the point through to the bottom of the horn, overlap to the horn, and hot glue in place.

• For the first unicorn ear count 3 knots over from the horn going towards the mane, Insert to the back with the pink portion facing outward.

• Hot glue in place.

• The second unicorn ear is 1 knot over IN the mane, pull through the center of the second row from the top, with the pink facing outward, glue in place.

• And you are done. This is being hung by the frame, not a ribbon. The orientation of the hang is so the horn faces right.
